FUSION!

On Wednesday nights the FLBC students meet for a student gathering called "Fusion." Fusion is a place where students meet together to learn God's word in community. We meet at the Connection Center from 5:30 until 8:00. Fusion provides a great environment to get to know other students, encounter Jesus through His word, and focus on fulfilling the great commission by making disciples of Jesus. Each week our students gather for a large group teaching time and then transition into a more personal small group time during which they spend time talking, processing, and praying about what's going on in their lives. Once a month we get together for a worship service called "Fusion:Remix" in which we worship God through music and through the teaching of God's word.

Using variety and creativity in the teachings, videos, music, and small groups, we hope for students to encounter truth in multiple ways.

The reason we do Fusion is to focus on Jesus. He is the capstone of the Bible, and our hope is that our students will begin to own their faith and learn to know Jesus personally.
